 - APNIC EC has referred this back to the Policy SIG:
 EC noted no clear consensus in favour of the policy, and noted concerns relating to adequate safeguards against potential abuse
- Mailing List Discussion June August 2009
 - 59 posts on this proposal
 - section 4 re-drafted on the list in the light of community suggestions and comments
 - no outstanding objections on the mailing list

Prop-50 version 5

 Detail added to section 4 to provide additional safeguards against potential abuse of transfers, based on community input on the mailing list

Record all transfers in a public record

Prior to APNIC unallocated pool exhaustion:

- eligibility criteria for transfers
- further assignments under exceptional circumstances only, with reporting of activity

Prop-50 version 5

This version of the proposal appears to represent the general consensus of the participants on the APNIC Policy SIG mailing list

We have added safeguards to address EC's noted concerns
